
Connect the left side element to the base bottom.





2 Attach the base bottom to the underside with 4 truss head screws M4x10.



3a Attach the back panel to the inside with 8 truss head screws M4x10.








Screw the 4 adjustable feet into the base bottom.

Set the base module down on the adjustable feet.



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



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
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Align the base module using the spirit level. To do this, turn the adjustable feet until the base module is level.






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#### Connection of a base module to an attachment kit

You can connect a base module to the barbecue attachment kit with 4 truss head screws.




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#### Connection of multiple base modules

You can connect multiple base modules with 4 truss head screws and 4 M4 stainless steel nuts.





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
